William J. Antholis, Managing Director of The Brookings Institution to Appear December 17th On The Neal Asbury Show on WZAB-AM



A William J. Antholis serves as the Managing Director of The Brookings Institution. In that capacity, he works directly with Brookings's President and Vice Presidents to help manage the full range of policy studies, develop new initiatives, coordinate research across programs, strengthen the policy impact of Brookings research, and ensure the quality and independence of that research. Dr. Antholis is also a Senior Fellow in Governance Studies, where his work focuses on the politics and institutions of international diplomacy. He has published articles, book chapters and opinion pieces on U.S. politics, U.S. foreign policy, international organizations, the G8, climate change, and trade. He leads the Brookings effort "How We're Doing: A Composite Index of Global and National Trends."

Prior to joining Brookings, he served for five years as Director of Studies and Senior Fellow at the German Marshall Fund, a U.S. grant-making and public policy institution devoted to strengthening transatlantic cooperation. In that capacity, Dr. Antholis was project director of the Trade and Poverty Forum, a six-country dialogue of leading private citizens and legislators focused on using the global economy to help address persistent global poverty and inequality.

From 1995 to 1999, Dr. Antholis served in government at both the White House and State Department. He was director of International Economic Affairs at the NSC and NEC, where he served as the chief staff person for the G8 Summits in 1997 and 1998, and also was Deputy Director of the White House Climate Change policy team. He also was an International Affairs Fellow of the Council on Foreign Relations and a Visiting Fellow at the Center of International Studies at Princeton University from 1999 to 2000.

In 1991, Dr. Antholis co-founded the Civic Education Project – a nonprofit organization that supports western-trained social science instructors at universities in 23 Central and Eastern European countries. He continues to serve on its board of directors.
