Congressman Tom Price Proposes that America Needs Big Citizens and a Small Government – Not the Other Way Around.



Kicking off his nationally syndicated “Neal Asbury’s Truth for America Show” on WZAB-AM, Neal Asbury opened the show by sharing the results of a recent PEW survey that found that only 25 percent of American citizens trust the government. “The survey illustrates what most of us already know: the government has been out of control for a long time. And what makes it worse is that the government doesn’t think we can make our own decisions,” said Asbury. “But while people don’t trust the government there is one group that they do trust: the American entrepreneur. They realize that small businesses are the lifeblood of the economy. Americans simply trust small business,” concluded Asbury.

Neal’s first guest was Congressman Tom Price (R-GA) who serves on the important Financial Services Committee and the Committee on Education and Labor, while also serving as the Ranking Republican on the Health, Employment, Labor and Pensions sub-committee. He is an MD and a small business owner, so he brings an informed perspective on healthcare and the economy.

To that end Price was very disappointed that the Republican physician caucus was not consulted by the Obama administration as they were preparing the health care bill.

“This is indicative of the Obama administration. They see that solutions are being put forth but they do not consult with anyone even though they don’t have any experience in vital areas such as healthcare, small business and energy,” said Price. “What also is missing is the American system of checks and balances. Pelosi and her gang are in charge and the only way to reinstate this system is at the ballot box.”

According to Price the American people are smarter than what they are given credit for. He maintains that people don’t like the direction the country

is going and are energized for change. They are putting their faith in small business.

“People remember how they got their first job. In most cases it was at a small business. That’s where they got their foot on the first rung of the ladder of success,” said Price.

Price is angry that the Obama administration is demonizing Wall Street. He maintains that deregulation did not cause financial institutions to fail—they failed because the government inserted itself into the process and forced banks to make loans they did not want to make. Price wants to see the end of bailouts once and for all. He also wants government to get out of people’s lives and instead step back and look at solutions that embrace American values.

“We want big citizens and a small government—not the other way around. Democrats are the party of Wall Street. Instead of punishing bankers, they are

being rewarded," said Price. He added that things are not likely to change if the Democrats don't show more backbone and continue to act as Pelosi's lapdogs.

Price predicts that voters are going to be flocking away from the power grab from the Left. He sees Republicans picking up at least fifty House seats during the midterm election.

Making an appearance on "Neal Asbury's Truth for America" was Gerry Czarnecki, who has written his newest book "Lead with Love." The book "engages managers at all levels to achieve peak performance by understanding and welcoming a new vision of leadership required to lead the many 'generations' in the work force."

Czarnecki's message is that managers shouldn't just like people, they should love them. He warns that if you merely like a worker you may be more apt to ignore some negative traits. This doesn't happen if you love them.

"I have an obligation to help employees achieve. A lot of leaders make the mistake of being friends with employees instead of being a mentor," said Czarnecki.

Czarnecki proposes that his obligation

as a business owner is to keep the organization alive so he can preserve jobs. His advice to business owners: hunker down, stay alive, and live to fight another battle.

He is greatly concerned about the growing threat of inflation. "You can't continue to run the money printing press without paying a price. That won't help pay down debt. Instead it will lead to an inflation spiral."

"The administration thinks that the solution for our economic problems is more government spending. The solution is encouraging entrepreneurs. Growth must come from the private sector, not from the public sector where most of the jobs created are low end and temporary. The quickest way to turn around the economy is to incentivize the private sector so that they invest and create jobs," concluded Czarnecki.
