



Ambassador John D. Negroponete to Appear on The Neal Asbury Show the Week of December 31st.



Arguably one of the most accomplished diplomats in U.S. history, Ambassador John D. Negroponete will appear on The Neal Asbury Show the week of July 8th for a fascinating and encompassing one-hour look into his storied career of nearly 45 years. Beginning at the U.S. Embassy in Vietnam during 1964 leading to his position as the Paris Peace Talks Liaison Officer, Negroponete has been in the forefront of key U.S. international affairs, including Asia, Iraq, Central America and NAFTA.

He was the U.S. Ambassador to Honduras during the Central American civil wars in the 1980's; worked in the White House providing President Ronald Reagan

daily briefings as the Deputy National Security Advisor; and was the U.S. Ambassador to Mexico during the entire NAFTA debate. He also was the U.S. Ambassador to the Philippines for the winding down of the U.S. bases, and was the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations during the lead up to the Iraq war that toppled Saddam Hussein, which culminated with his becoming the first U.S. Ambassador to a free Iraq. A watershed moment for Negroponete was his becoming the first Director of National Intelligence and providing President George W. Bush daily briefings on America's security issues and finally as the Deputy Secretary of State.

Ambassador Negroponete has received numerous awards in recognition of his more than four decades of public service, including the State Department's Distinguished Service Medal on two separate occasions, the highest award which can be conferred by the Secretary of State, and on January 16, 2009, President Bush awarded Ambassador Negroponete the National Security Medal for his outstanding contributions to U.S. national security.
