Former House Majority Leader Tom DeLay to Appear on The Neal Asbury Show the Week of November 5th.

In 2006, DeLay co-authored the New York Time's best-selling book titled "No Retreat, No Surrender: One American's Fight" which includes his memoirs, an ambitious conservative agenda that can unite Republicans, and his call on conservatives to rebuild the movement based upon the First Principles of Order, Justice, and Freedom. Whether it's national television and radio interviews or offering commentary and analysis for major media, DeLay is one of the most-sought after conservatives on the national scene.

DeLay also spends a great deal of his time educating conservatives on how to fight in the new political paradigm. That includes traveling around the country and meeting with major donors, fundraisers, and political operatives, encouraging them to pay more attention to what the Left is accomplishing and how, and asking for their involvement with more outside organizations.

In addition to his political work, DeLay and his wife, Christine, continue to be outspoken advocates for foster care reform and are actively involved in Rio Bend, a unique foster care community in Richmond, Texas,

that provides safe, permanent homes for abused and neglected kids.
